Planning council recommends change to OSLC constitution

Currently the constitution of OSLC states in amendment C9.21.:

"When the Lead Pastor resigns or is terminated, all other pastoral staff shall tender their resignations within thirty days after the arrival of the new Lead Pastor."

As a planning council, we recommend removing this from our constitution so that we do not lose valuable members of our staff. OSLC amendment *C17.04 states:

"The Congregation Council shall notify the congregation's members of the proposal together with the council's recommendations at least 30 days in advance of the meeting."

This letter will serve as this notification. This change will be voted on at the annual meeting in August in accordance with the following amendment: "C17.01.a. be approved at a legally called Congregation Meeting according to this constitution by a majority vote of those present and voting; b. be ratified without change at the next annual meeting by a two-thirds majority vote of those present and voting; and c. have the effective date included in the resolution2 and noted in the constitution."

Again, this is an outdated amendment, so it is important that it is eliminated. For clarification, OSLC planning council at this time recommends eliminating amendment C9.21 from OSLC constitution, and this action will be voted on at our annual meeting. Please bring any questions or concerns to planning council members.

Treasurer's Report

Statement of Operations - We have generated \$515k YTD in income compared to \$555k YTD budget. April general income was \$41k. General expenses were \$555k YTD, compared to \$538k YTD budget. Facility expenses, utility costs, staff & pension/health expenses are running higher than plan YTD.

Balance Sheet & Cash Flow - Cash has increased \$32K YTD, primarily driven by the receipt of dedicated funds. Our overall cash balance is \$123k, including \$161k allocated to dedicated accounts.

THE CHURCH VAN



Urgent Need: it is critical that we raise approximately \$18,000 dollars to replace the church van.

The facts (otherwise known as the bad news):

- #1: The van we are <u>still using to transport OSLC members to/from church events</u> (COW activities, Faith on Friday's, Jesus and Me, Summer Stretch, Mission Trips, and Amazing Greys) "jumps" out of park and into drive which is scary and dangerous to passengers and pedestrians.
- #2: Our current van is a 1996 Ford E350 (27 years old) and it has 146,000 miles on it.
- #3: Our current van has been repaired with duct tape to cover metal that is protruding from a seat back, and the rubber seal around the windshield repaired with super glue.
- #4: The vendor we have bought from in the past is planning to retire in the next few years and in preparation wants to sell ½ his fleet in mid August
- #5: Buying similar vans from other vendors will cost \$10,000- 12,000 more than purchasing from him. So, we have a small window to capitalize on purchasing something that is needed, from a known vendor, at the best price.

The good news:

- #1: OSLC already has \$12,000 in a dedicated account to purchase a multi passenger van from a past funding drive. Thank you to all that donated last time!
- #2: The vendor that is more affordable is confident that they will have a van for us to buy in the middle of August that is a 2018 or 2019 model with 70-80,000 miles of experience for approximately \$30,000 dollars. Last year many vendors were selling similar vans for \$50,000 or more due to COVID inflation, so it is a blessing we have this option.

I understand that OSLC has a lot on our plate, but replacing the van is truly a need. We need to make sure our staff, volunteers and youth are safe. You can make a donation on Breeze, in the offering plate on Sundays or mail it to the church office. Just mark in the notes "church van" so we know it is for this critical need.
