Treasurer's Report

Financial Statement - Year to date we have received \$508k against our budgeted revenue of \$616.7k Our YTD Expenses are \$624.2k compared to a budget of \$630.2k This puts us at a negative \$116k year to date. However, because of the Employee Retention Credit of \$34,038, we are now at a negative \$81k.

Balance Sheet & Cash Flow - The total of cash and accounts receivable is \$184.5k. Funds allocated to dedicated accounts is \$170.1k. We have had to draw from our savings over the last 2 months to pay our bills and dedicated accounts are at risk.

The Congregation Council is actively evaluating ministry plans and will engage the congregation in decision making regarding putting forth a balanced budget for 2026.


3rd Grade Bibles – Faith Stepping Stone


All third-grade students and their parents are invited to attend the 3rd Grade Bible Faith Stepping Stone January 4th - February 8th (no class Jan 18th).


