Description:

For 50 years, ELCA World Hunger's approach to ending hunger has focused on "root causes" of poverty, addressing the forces in our world that drive people to food insecurity. In recent years, ELCA World Hunger has tightened how we understand this work to an acronym, M.E.R.G.E.: ending hunger requires attention to migrant, environmental, racial, gender, and economic justice. This talk will explore how the M.E.R.G.E. justice principles are driving ELCA World Hunger's work—from direct action to granting—and how they can support your community's own approach to ending hunger.

CCBP 2025 Report

We are proud to celebrate the 30th year of our program! In the spring of 2025, Centennial School District staff registered students in need for free school supplies in each of the district's schools.

232 elementary and 20 high school student backpacks were adopted and packed by 92 individuals and 6 community organizations. Adopters received a supply list specific to their student, then purchased and packed a backpack with all the items on the list. The cost of filling an average backpack with needed supplies is \$60-\$120 depending on the school and grade. We are very grateful for our adopters!...

Thank you to everyone who joined in the fun! Keep an eye out for our next Game Night — you won't want to miss it!














12 Life Lessons of the Psalms

Treasurer's Report

Statement of Operations - We have generated \$387k in YTD Total Income. Our YTD Expenses are \$442k. This puts us at a negative \$55k year to date. However, because of the Employee Retention Credit of \$34,038, our YTD results are a negative \$20.3k.

Summer often brings a dip in financial giving as we go in many different directions. As we transition back from summer, let's ensure our church continues to thrive. Consider stepping up your giving to support our mission to Create, Equip, Serve, and Grow, enabling us to make a difference in the world around us.

Balance Sheet & Cash Flow - The total of cash and accounts receivable is \$266.9k. Funds allocated to dedicated accounts is \$196.4k.

Connections Bread Baking Classes 2025

This Fall the Connections Team will be offering bread-baking classes led by resident baker Mark Gustafson. Mark has been an enthusiastic baker for about 28 years, but who's counting? He led an adult baking small group 2004-2005 at Our Saviors and more recently has done baking with Youth Club for about 10 years. No experience is necessary and you can sign up for one or both sessions. The good news is that you will go home with a recipe and hot, fresh bread that you created from scratch. Ingredients will be supplied, bring a favorite apron and be ready to have a good time! Ingredient expense \$5.00/person.

For session 2 we will take a deep dive into the Old Testament and make Ezekiel 4:9 bread, using the Biblical recipe as our starting point. We will start by milling and grinding/mashing some of the ingredients, then mix and knead and let it rise. During the rising we will attempt to make sense of the Ezekiel 4:9 and related scripture that led us to this special bread. Ezekiel 4:9 formed into rolls have been a Youth Club favorite so we will bake a multitude of rolls. Sampling our "holy" rolls will complete this session.








Noah's Ark: Bring Your Bible from Home Week


