### **Growing Together in Christ: Bible Study**

Pr Walter will lead a Thursday Bible Study on the Book of Revelation beginning Thursday February 1 at 10:00AM. The sessions will be held on Feb 1, 15, 29, March 7, 21, April 4 and 18.

### Is This The Time? Interpreting the Mystery of Revelation

This teaching resource will provide a much-needed, truly biblical perspective on what is arguably the most difficult book of the Bible. Presented by Dr. Craig Koester, professor of New Testament at Luther Seminary, this video series helps us discover Revelation's message of God's love and hope for the world, shrouded in symbolism, prophecy, conflict and fear. Dr Koester mines the rich material from his popular course, workshops and books.

Koester's intimate, personal and direct explication makes for a dynamic and engaging learning experience. The teacher's mission: "I want you to believe all of what God wants you to believe about Revelation." Dr. Koester uses the rich histories of art and music to tell the story of the entire Book of Revelation. He examines the sensationalistic interpretations of Revelation and related apocalyptic theories, showing why these approaches are problematic.

Reading: Book of Revelation and Revelation and All Things (2nd Edition) by Dr Craig Koester. Please sign up for the study so that the book may be purchased for approximately \$30 (which will help cover the cost of the teaching DVD).

#### Treasurer's Report

Statement of Operations - We have generated \$181.2k in General income compared to \$229.1k budgeted (down \$47.9k from current budget. General expenses were \$211.7k YTD, coming in under our YTD budget of \$228.9k. At the end of our stub period, with income less than plan and expenses coming in under plan, we are showing a shortfall of \$29.95k. More detail will be shared for the upcoming annual meeting.

### Livestreaming

Unfortunately, we are experiencing a decrease in the reliability of the online livestream service we bring to our congregants. Therefore, we are unable to guarantee livestreaming or recording of services for the foreseeable future.

Without a hired staff person to engineer our audio/visual needs, we are limited in our ability to problem solve when issues arise. Is it our hardware? Software? Network issues? All of our amazing volunteers are doing their best to make streaming available, but there may be instances when it is simply just not available.


## "ALL GOD'S CHILDREN GOTTA SING!"
