We are celebrating the 29th year of the **Centennial Community Backpack Program** ministry at OSLC. Last year, with your support, we were able to provide over 390 backpacks with supplies to Centennial students. We need your help now, more than ever, as the need for support continues to grow.

4 ways you can support the Centennial Community Backpack Program:

1. Adopt a backpack for student(s) by clicking [adopt a backpack](#)
 - a. Please complete the registration form as soon as possible, so we can determine the number of students adopted.
 - b. The cost for a backpack and supplies range from \$50- \$100. Please keep this in mind if you plan to adopt multiple backpacks for students.
 - c. If you register to adopt a backpack, please fulfill your obligation as it is difficult to fill backpacks at the last minute.
 - d. A letter with a school supply list and backpack drop off information will be mailed to you in June.
2. Click [donate online](#) to make a monetary donation (select Backpack/school supplies in the first dropdown), or write a check to OSLC with *Backpack* in the memo line. Monetary donations are used to provide backpacks and supplies to Middle and High School students as well as extra supplies for each of the schools.
3. Donate your empty ink cartridges—there's a box in the Narthex. We receive \$1 in merchandise for every cartridge we recycle.
4. Spread the word by sharing our website centennialbackpack.org or Facebook page [Centennial Community Backpack Program](#) to your friends, family, neighbors, businesses, co-workers, clubs, etc. If you know of a family in the Centennial School District needing to sign-up their child(ren) for a backpack, inform the family to contact their school office.
