- 3) We hosted another successful <u>9th grade retreat</u> at Camp WAPO this past month. We were joined by All Saints Church from Minnetonka. WAPO improved upon our last experience (which was poor), so we were glad to see that our concerns had been taken

- into consideration. The theme of the retreat was based on the letters of the Apostle Paul and how we are one body in Christ.
