This means that every donation dollar will be matched by another dollar up to \$70,000. With monies paid for 2024 and pledges, we basically have only \$50,000 left to make our goal.


Feed My Starving Children Event

A workday in April was used by many to get a head start on cleanup and weed prevention and the following are people who have taken a plot to care for around the church grounds.






